Wall Templates are pre-designed process charts that facilitators can use for various group purposes. The charts are printed with various graphics as metaphors intended to guide the group through a process. Experienced facilitators may be able to use a Wall Template without guiding instructions. However, each template has an available “Leaders Guide” designed for the process.

Wall Templates are only available from one source (known). “The Grove” is a consulting firm headquartered in San Francisco, CA that provides professionals, training and resources for graphic facilitation. Its founder, David Sibbet, is one of the pioneers of what has become known as Graphic Facilitation and Graphic Recording. They describe wall templates as “Visual Planning Systems - toolsets that guide groups and individuals through processes of reflection, direction-setting and planning.” There are 20 process templates that range from Meeting Startup, Context Mapping, Gameplans, Visioning, SPOT, Roadmaps and many more. Each design has a Leaders Guide available for purchase with the step by step process detailed.
